Commitment to Recycling

Pactiv Evergreen is a founding member of the Carton Council of North America, the Paper Recovery Alliance and the Plastics Recovery Group



- Formed in 2009, the Carton Council is an industry organization committed to growing carton recycling in the U.S.
- By promoting both recycling technology and local collection programs, as well as growing awareness that cartons are recyclable, we work to limit the number of cartons that become waste.



- The PRA and PRG were formed in 2011 with a goal of increasing the recycling infrastructure for foodservice packaging.
- The work includes aligning supply chain partners, promoting development of the processing infrastructure, development of end markets for recycled materials, and educating and engaging stakeholders to increase recovery.

FPI RESULTS BY THE NUMBERS

RESULTS

- 5.9M households added since 2017
- 3.29% access add
- Reduction in contamination at the MRF
- Increase in resident participation
 - Increase in fiber into the system
 - Increase in bin or cart requests

EXAMPLES

- Washington DC
 - Contamination decreased from 33% to 26%
 - Increased mixed paper from 9% to 20%
- Chattanooga, TN
 - Contamination decreased from 14% to 7%
 - Increase fiber collection from 62% to 73%
